LLANGADOG BURIAL AUTHORITY**

**REGULATIONS APPERTAINING TO LLANGADOG LAWN CEMETERY**

1. All new graves are designated Lawn. No kerbs, border stones, fencing, shrubs, rose bushes or any other obstructions are allowed on the surface of the grave.
2. Glass ornaments, excessive planting, and large obstructions are not permitted on graves
3. Temporary wooden crosses are permitted (for a maximum period of 2 years) subject to the approval of the Llangadog Community Council. Once a permanent memorial is erected on the grave, these temporary wooden crosses are to be removed from the cemetery grounds.
4. No scattering of ashes will be allowed.
5. All memorials shall be constructed of **Black or Dark Grey** granite or marble stone and shall be in accordance with the dimensions indicated on the appropriate application form. All memorials shall be supplied and erected by a firm of Monumental Masons who will be responsible for completing the necessary application forms and payments of fees as required by the Burial Authority.
6. The owner of a grave shall be responsible for the continuous maintenance of any memorial erected on the grass space, and shall, if it becomes dangerous or dilapidated, cause it to be restored to pristine condition or arrange for its removal from the Cemetery grounds upon receipt of official notification from the Burial Authority.
7. Responsibility for the removal of Memorials to facilitate further interments is solely with the owner of the grave who is responsible for arranging its re-instatement on the grave space within **6 months** of the day old such interments, or arrange with the Burial Authority for its removal from the cemetery grounds. Permission must be obtained from the Clerk to enter the cemetery before any work can begin.
8. In all cases a minimum of six months will elapse after an interment before the surface of the grave is finally levelled, turfed or seeded.
9. The following is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**:
  - a. The discharge of any firearms (except when authorised by the Authority at Military Funerals).
  - b. The playing of games.
  - c. Pedal cycles, roller skates, skateboards, or similar wheeled items.
  - d. No dogs allowed.
  - e. Gates MUST be shut within the vicinity of the Lawn Cemetery
  - f. No alcohol to be brought or consumed in the cemetery.
  - g. No glass or china vases to be placed on the grave.
  - h. No ornaments and such like to be placed on the headstone only and not on the grassed areas.
  - i. No petrol strimmers or other grass cutting implements to be used in the cemetery apart from those items used by the official cemetery caretakers.
10. Reservation of a plot for future burial is **not** permitted.
11. Furniture or plaques placed on the Lawn Cemetery are done so at the owner's risk.
12. Rubbish is not allowed to be left in any area.
